Injured skier sues Vail Resorts Inc.

RENO, Nev. — A Florida skier has sued the owner of Heavenly Mountain Resort on Lake Tahoe's south shore, claiming she was seriously injured when an employee crashed into her in January.

The lawsuit, filed on behalf of Miami-area paramedic Kimberly Bland on Wednesday in Reno federal court, alleges Vail Resorts Inc. is liable for its employee's negligence.

The Reno Gazette-Journal reported that Bland was knocked unconscious and suffered injuries to her head, neck, shoulder and back. The suit seeks at least \$350,000 in damages, plus costs.
